

PRAYER PROMPTS – MARCH 22-28

“The history of missions is the history of answered prayer.” Samuel Zwemer

KNOWING GOD BETTER. Read EXODUS 3:1-15.

Has God ever showed you something “extraordinary” in the midst of the ordinary?

Has God ever spoken to you audibly?

What does the name “I AM WHO I AM” mean to you?                      Worship this God.

CONFESSION: Sometimes, it may be easier to enter into a time of confession following the pattern of Psalm 79:8-9. Confess the sins of past generation first, then our sins.

“Do not hold against us the sins of past generations; may your mercy come quickly to meet us, for we are in desperate need. Help us, God our Savior, for the glory of Your Name; deliver us and forgive OUR sins for your Name’s sake.”

LOVING OTHERS BETTER – UNITY. ROMANS 1:11-12. “I long to see you that I may impart to you some spiritual gift to make you strong – that is, that you and I may be mutually encouraged by each other’s faith.”

Pray that there would be this eagerness to share truth with others as well as to receive truth from others, giving and receiving, a true unity among believers. Pray the same for believers in Basque Country.

LOVING GOD AND SERVING OTHERS BETTER. 1 PETER 3:15. “But in your hearts, revere Christ as Lord. Always be ready to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect.”

Pray to revere and worship and love God as you should, and then in that spirit, to be willing to give an answer to those who ask you the reason for your hope. Pray the same for those in Basque Country.

THE DARKNESS IN BASQUE COUNTRY. The history of the 16th century in Spain was one of severe persecution for those who attempted to translate Scriptures or distribute copies of the Bible. The Bible became a forbidden book and those who promoted it were eliminated. Even today, there is still some that attitude with regards to God’s Word. Pray that many in Basque Country would have the curiosity pick up a Bible or even a phone app of the Bible and discover for themselves what God want to tell them about His love for them.
