

## Imagine.

Today, we are going to walk through some of the ways God talks about light all throughout His Word. There is no better place to start than the beginning.

In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.

The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. And God said, 'Let there be light, 'and there was light.

#### Genesis 1:1-3

Imagine being there and watching God speak and command light to illuminate the darkness.

It says in the passage that God spoke and called forth the light. Where can I speak light into darkness today?

Right now take some time to pray for Christ followers living in Basque Country, that they would have opportunities today to speak light into darkness.

#### Praise.

Scripture also refers to God as the One who is the light by which we see.

How precious is Your unfailing love, O God! All humanity finds shelter in the shadow of Your wings. You feed them from the abundance of Your own house, letting them drink from Your river of delights. For You are the fountain of life, the light by which we see.

Take some time to praise God for being the way by which we see clearly and for His abundance.

#### Ask.

God calls us to join Him in spreading light.

"Here's another way to put it: You're here to be light, bringing out the God-colors in the world. God is not a secret to be kept. We're going public with this, as public as a city on a hill. If I make you light-bearers, you don't think I'm going to hide you under a bucket, do you? I'm putting you on a light stand. Now that I've put you there on a hilltop, on a light stand—shine! Keep open house; be generous with your lives. By opening up to others, you'll prompt people to open up with God, this generous Father in heaven."
